Venous duplex examination using 2-D imaging, color flow and spectral Doppler was performed.

INDICATION: Edema

FINDINGS: The common femoral vein, femoral vein, popliteal vein, peroneal veins and posterior tibial veins were all assessed for patency.

Right: 2-D imaging demonstrates a non-compressible, non occlusive and dilated distal femoral vein. All other vessels are well visualized, compressible and demonstrate phasic, competent flow with normal augmentation.

Left: 2-D imaging demonstrates all vessels are well visualized, compressible and demonstrate phasic, competent flow with normal augmentation.

IMPRESSION:

- 1) Evidence of a non-compressible, non occlusive and dilated DVT of the right distal femoral vein.
- 2) All other vessels are well visualized and compressible.
